

COMPANION: only one, who arrives with you leaves with you and if he doesn't arrive with you he can no longer arrive





5 THINGS TO DO



BRING WITH YOU A PAINKILLER

one of those simple, light ones that you take in case of a headache or something; it's not a hymn to the use of drugs, I'm not really the type, but it's a spare tire to carry with you \wedge \wedge



BRING A SNACK

because you are not SUPERMAN unfortunately and your body may need to supplement sugars to keep your blood sugar high



DO I NEED TO TAKE OFF HAIR?

YES, between 24h and 48h before the appointment so as not to arrive with irritated skin



A BEAUTIFUL SHOWER

when you enter a tattoo studio you immediately notice the cleanliness, the smell and the aesthetics of the place and of the tattoo artist... well, it's mutual



SLEEP

you need to arrive in the best physical condition possible cause your body is about to suffer an injury

NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS

first of all, if you are not able to understand and want you cannot get a tattoo, the law says so, that bitch. then - worse - alcohol and drugs are vasodilators and blood thinners and you are about to injure yourself, which doesn't help

NO TIGHT CLOTHES

the body reacts to a tattoo by swelling, sometimes a lot, and a tight dress may no longer fit

NO TANNED OR IRRITADE SKIN

tanned skin is totally against a large tattoo, much less a colored one; tanned skin becomes irritated, swollen and bleeds much more easily, endangering the final result

NO TO FASTING

because we don't want fainting due to drops in sugar or blood pressure; your body will work a lot and therefore needs energy

NO STRESS

always keep yourself longer than expected because the tattoo you are about to get will remain for life and must be done calmly, like all things done well
